From Hillary Davison, Minister of Music

I Corinthians 12:1-11

Growing up in the Pentecostal Holiness Church, speaking in tongues was a measure of spirituality to some and totally weird and scary to others, particularly my friends who grew up in other denominations. I remember being in church and feeling the Holy Spirit fall on our congregation. I remember the hair standing up on the back of my neck when a message was given in tongues and how the whole church fell silent, waiting on the soon-coming interpretation. I remember knowing that it was from God, and I wanted it so bad. Throughout my whole life, I felt that I had never had the very deepest connection with God because I had never been given the gift of speaking in tongues. It wasn't until I became a young adult that I understood that speaking in tongues is but ONE spiritual gift that the Lord gives to His disciples. The scripture teaches us that different disciples possess different gifts, but that they are all from God and of God.

Sometimes I think that we get discouraged if we don't possess the same gifts and talents as others. Maybe someone sings better than me. Maybe someone prays better than me. Maybe someone quotes scripture better than me. Maybe someone teaches better than me. It is easy for us, the humans that God made us, to compare our gifts and talents to others. I have found myself in this place many times throughout my life. It is important to remember that God designed us to be unique. He gives us unique gifts and wants us to USE them for His glory and for building His kingdom of believers. Each individual gift is given to be used to show the world who Jesus is. You may not be speaking in tongues, but you may be speaking life into a lost person or teaching other believers through your spiritual wisdom. You may have the faith to move mountains and to believe that healing will come. You may have the gift to prophesy over a young person who has no direction in this incredibly lost world. You may be able to recognize the spirit of Evil and rebuke the Devil. And you may be able to interpret a spiritual message that God gives to another in a language that is unknown. I want to challenge you to find and use your gift. Using these gifts will be the gateway to knowing God so much deeper, and to win the lost in this world to Jesus. Find ways to use your gifts in the church, through your ministry area or through service. Find ways to use your gifts among your friend groups. And find ways to use your gifts in this world that so desperately needs to know the love and forgiveness of Jesus.
